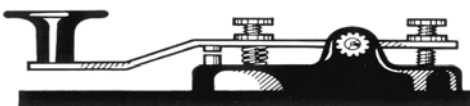

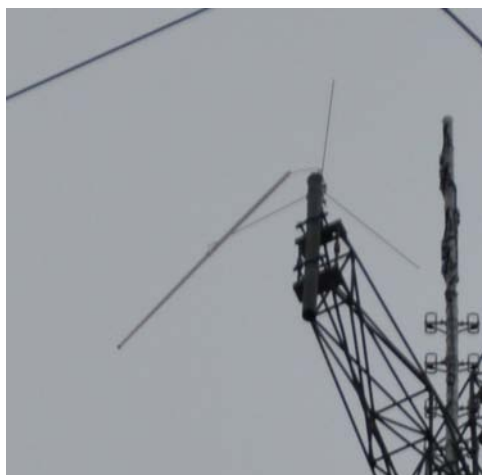

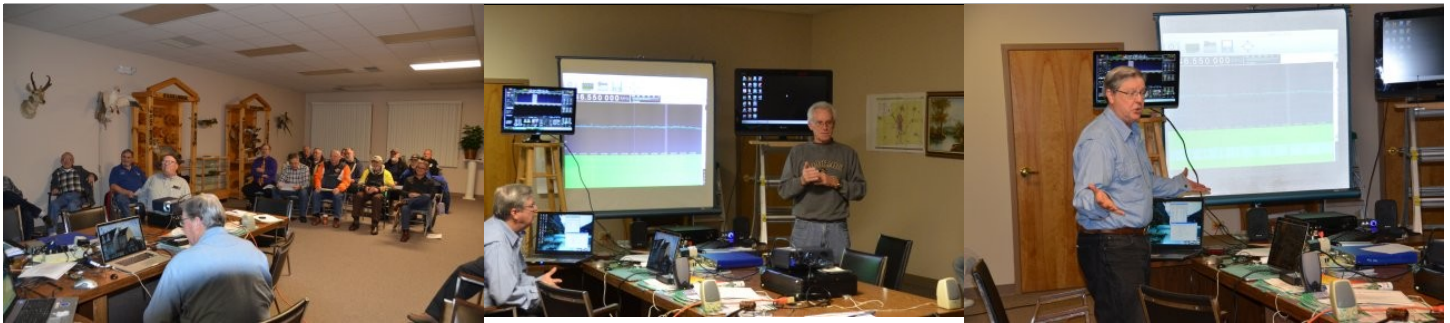

TORNADO DAMAGE BLUES!

Jerry WB9Z knew that he would have a mountain of work piled up when he returned from the [Wake Island DXpedition](#). However, he couldn't have foreseen the damage caused by the November 17th tornados! Jerry has three crews out trying to repair/restore numerous AT&T and Verizon sites plus many other broadcast and telecommunication tower installations. He also has to close his business books for the year and be ready for the six week journey and operation on [Amsterdam Island](#) in the Indian Ocean! WOW! Watch your health Jerry!

Along those lines, the 500ft tower in Diamond that holds the KARS remote .34 receive antenna was hit by the tornado. The tower survived but the KARS antenna didn't. A replacement is at the site.

The new cavity has been installed in the .34/.94 repeater. The results were immediate. The repeater now has the wide area coverage it had in the past.
