Also, to Howard AK9F (SK) who arranged the antenna perch and donated the antenna. Further thanks to Jerry WB9Z for providing the necessary, professional crew to install the antenna. Plus to Don K9NR, Clay N9IO, Rollie N9RJM and Bill N9OE for the electronic side of the project.

Feel free to use the machine...we are anxious to hear how it is working.

IMPORTANT! Operation during severe weather conditions...

The NWS has asked KARS to move local weather spotting reports to the .130 repeater. This will free up the .34/.94 machine for reports to the NWS station WX9LOT. The WX Bureau forecast center is a VERY busy place in severe weather. They monitor five ham repeaters all around the Chicago area. The KARS .34/.94 machine is important because:

It is south where the bad weather tends to come from.

Iroquois and Indiana Counties can relay through to WX9LOT.

This means that net control stations will have to monitor both 146.940 and 145.130 simultaneously. To reiterate, local stations report to KARS net control on 145.130 and not 146.940. Net control then relays reports to WX9LOT on 146.940. If you find yourself in a position where you have important weather information for the net but cannot hit the 145.130 machine...by all means use 146.940 if necessary.




