KARS HOLIDAY BANQUET

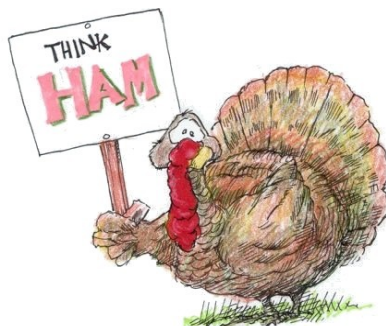

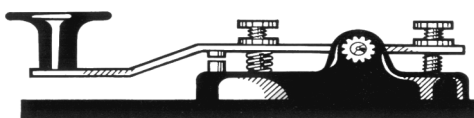

2019 DXPEDITION NEWS

KARS member Jerry WB9Z, more or less recovered from the ill fated Bouvet Island DXpedition will be part of an experienced team of 14 to operate from Pitcairn Island located in the highly isolated South Pacific in October of next year.

The team consisting of AA7A, EY8MM, JR4OZR, K0IR, K0PC, K9CT, N2TU, N4GRN, N6HC, W0GJ, W0VTT, W6IZT, W8HC and WB9Z will be there for two weeks operating on all bands and modes.

The good ole' reliable RV Braveheart will be their mode of transportation. The team is currently working on constructing their website and hope to have it live "soon with more details."

BTW. If Pitcairn Island sounds familiar, it was the place Fletcher Christian sailed the HMS Bounty after taking the ship from the infamous Captain Bligh. Yes, Mutiny on the Bounty was based on a true story! Since Tom Christian VR6TC became a Silent Key, Pitcairn has become a fairly rare DX catch, so this DXpedition will be popular. Note the name Tom "Christian." Yes, a direct descendent of ole' Fletcher was a ham operator!
