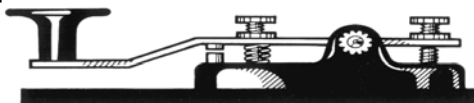

That younger person will be Central Division Vice-Director Kermit Carlson W9XA. Kermit, a Senior Engineering Physicist at Fermilab, has been Dick Isely's running mate since they were first elected in 2001.

Replacing Kermit Carlson as Vice-Director is well known propagation guru Carl Luetzelschwab K9LA.

Isely has been elected an ARRL Honorary Vice-President by the ARRL BOD.
