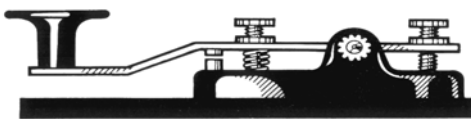

It was from this antenna feed assembly that Jerry and Val took photos and videos.

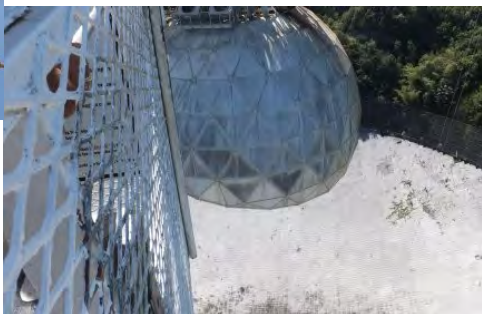
