

RXAssistant Version 2.,5 is available for downlowd on the KARS Web Site. W9AZ.com No Big changes but the new version will handle messaging to the User/Program in a better way

When the Radio is Disconnected or turned off it will indicate the Radio has been disconnected. When this occurs it is necessary to re run the program.

Also if the program is run before the radio is turned on it will handle the prompt to double click on the IP in a cleaner way.

RXAssistant is a program app intended to Add <u>Advanced Receive Antenna Assistance</u> <u>Option Selection</u> to any of the <u>FlexRadio</u> 6XXX Radios running SmartSDR versions 2.6.1 or greater or any 3.x version.

Clickable buttons in the on-screen GUI add additional functions such as quick toggle access to the <u>Binaural Audio</u>, <u>Headphone/Speaker</u> and <u>Diversity Receive</u>.

Plus two special buttons

A1/A and A2/B with Hot Key access via Keyboard keys [and] respectively.

You could optionally minimize(-) the app off the desktop and still have full access to ALL RX Antennas while maintaining focus on the keyboard. (Hot Key Access implemented at the request of Craig K9CT) Full explanation of all in the included instruction page .pdf file.
