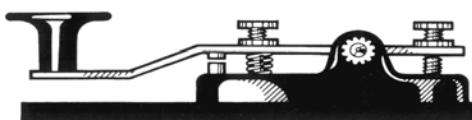

Don't forget! The 2020 Illinois QSO Party is Sunday, October 18th, 12 Noon to 8PM. Operation is on all bands 160 through 2 meters and all modes CW/SSB/FM/Digital. The exchange is your RS(T) and county or RS(T) and state for non-Illinois stations.

If you don't have HF gear, check out the activity on the FM simplex channels. FM contacts must be simplex and not through repeaters.

So...please jump in and help out. You don't have to operate the entire contest. Just hop in anytime and make a few contacts. **Be sure to submit your log with "KANKAKEE AREA RADIO SOCIETY" for the club aggregate score!**
