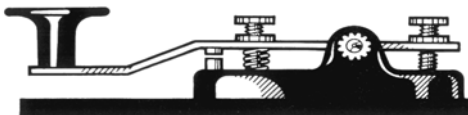

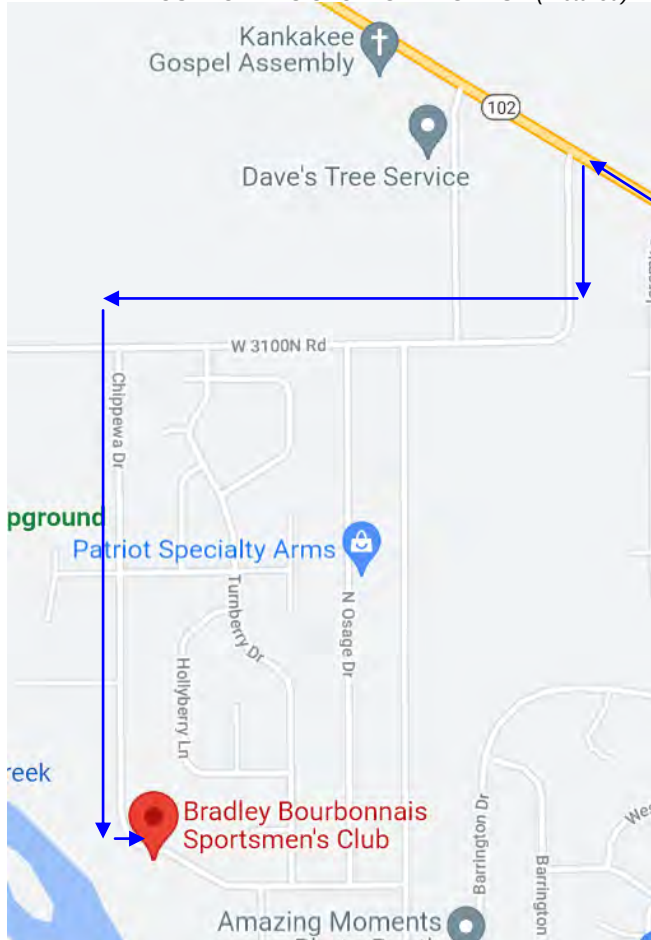

THE BEST LOGGING PROGRAMS

By a very wide margin, [N1MM+ Logger](#) is the most popular contest logging software in the world. It is comprehensive and regularly updated. It checks for updates every time it is run.

It includes an elementary routine logging program but it really shines as a contest logging program.

It can be easily downloaded and it is totally freeware, not crippleware or half activated.

For station logging, [DXLab](#) is extremely popular. It is great for rig control, general logging, auto logging, QSLing, DX chasing and award chasing. ...continued in next column

Top Right...The fox (Tony AA9CC) in his lair by rural Essex.

Top Left...Tony was at a park that was adjacent to the old Kankakee & Seneca RR grade. Built in 1881 and abandoned 50 years later in 1931 the railroad connected the Big Four RR in Kankakee with the Rock Island RR in Seneca.

To place it in perspective, the gunfight at the OK Corral in Tombstone Arizona occurred on October 26, 1881.

It's been 141 years since the railroad was built and 91 years since the last train traversed this grade. You can still find grades, culverts, bridges and more of this railroad on Google Earth. There were stations in Bonfield, Essex and several other small towns along the way.
