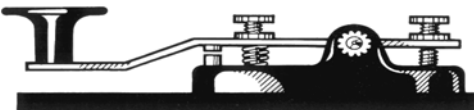

A graduate of Reed -Custer Junior High and a member of Tri-Parish Catholic Communities, he is an honor roll student involved in Scholastic Bowl, Habitat for Humanity, Augustinian Youth Ministry, and the Math Team. He is also a member of the National Honor Society. As an athlete, he has competed on the Cross Country and Track and Field teams at Providence Catholic. His junior year, he earned Most Improved Player for both cross country and track and field. He also serves as the co-captain of the cross country team this year. He plans to study Electrical Engineering in college. "Classes at Providence changed the way I think and approach problems, so now I have a mindset that is much more prepared for the challenges of college courses," says Dau. "The two courses that exemplified this the most are my Honors Physics and AP English Language and Composition my junior year. 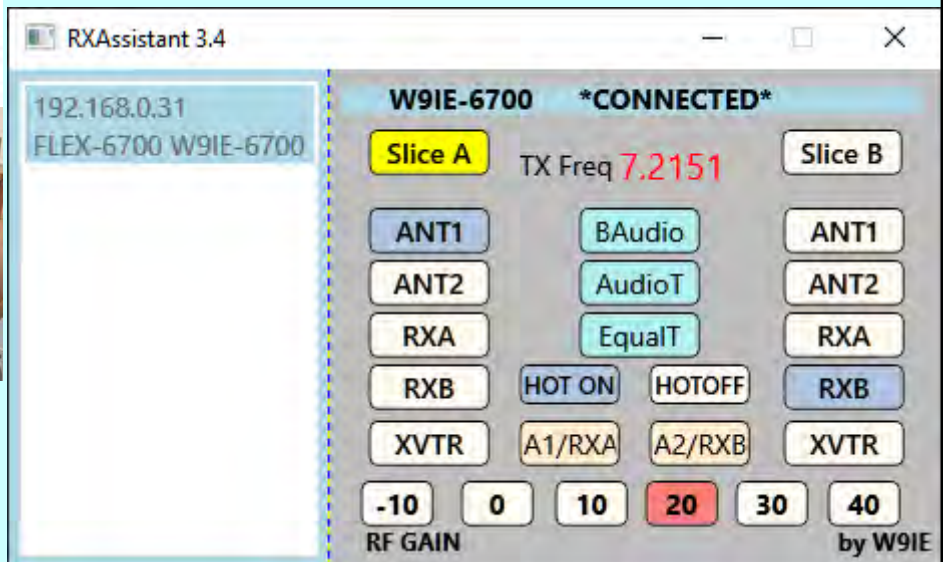
Ken realized there was a need for this program to simplify many RX related functions on the fly. Through input of like minded contesters and DXers the program has definitely matured into the much liked program it is today.

RXAssistant Version 3.4

RXAssistant is a Windows Program intended to provide Point and Click Selection of Many of the "RECEIVE" options buried in Menus in SmartSDR on your PC or Maestro Screen. IE: it's name **RXAssistant**.

It will run on any Flex 6xxx Radio using SmartSDR Version 2.6.1 or greater. Options viewable below on the GUI Screen are self explanatory but additional information is available in the User PDF downloadable (below).

NOTE: These operations can still be limited or modified by your Radio Model.

Download link and Download instructions are available (below).

Version 3.2 Has a new look and also will remember your selected Screen Position. Version 3.4 added the ability to turn the Hot Keys function On and Off with two new buttons. Full explanation in the User Doc.
