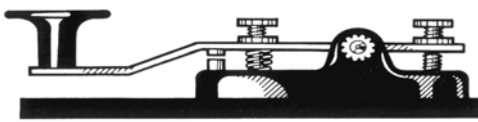

Your club needs you...be a part of the team! Did I forget to mention, it's a heck of a lot of fun! Let K9NR know of your intentions to operate.

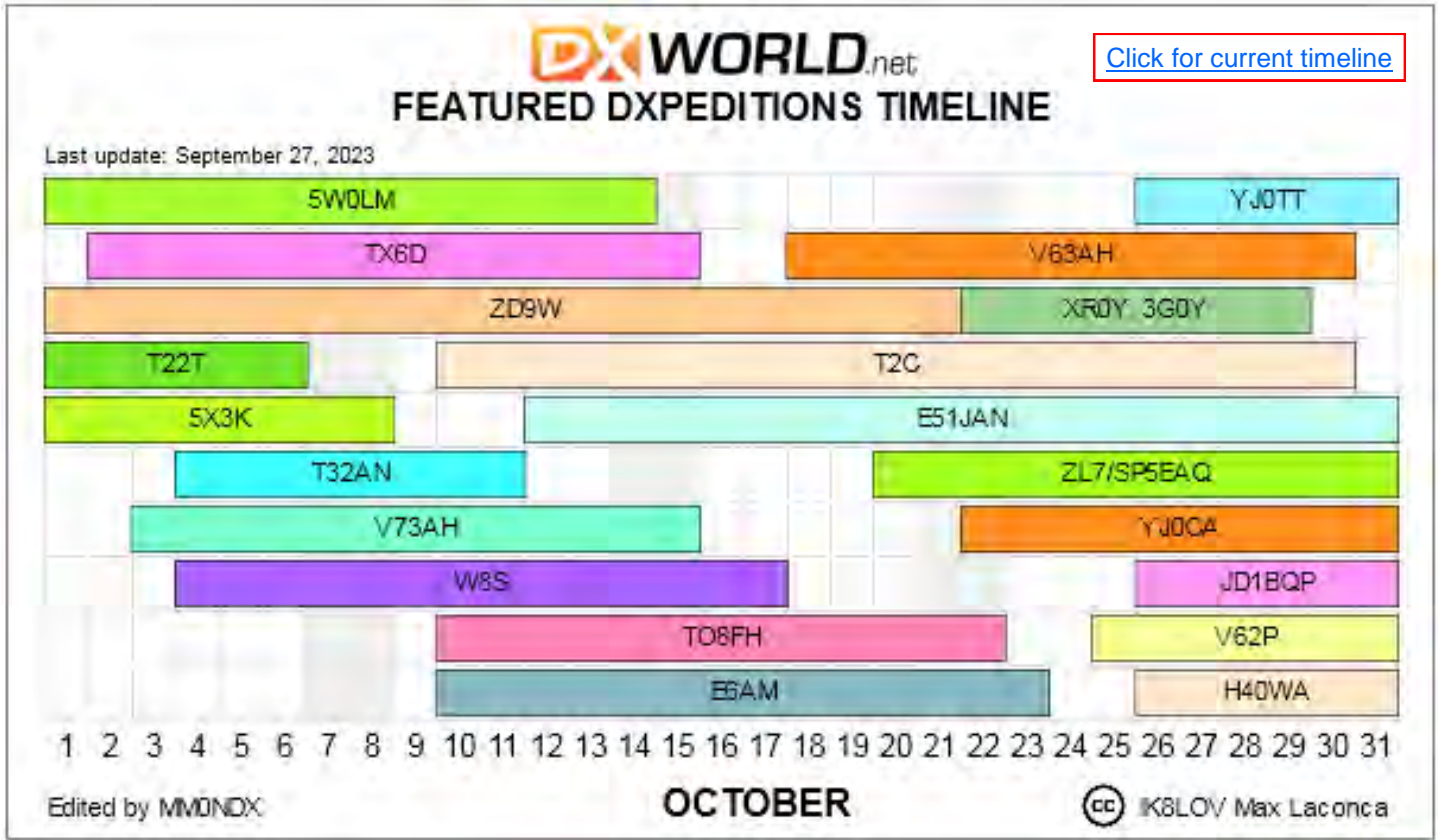

Don't forget! The 2023 Illinois QSO Party is Sunday, October 22nd, 12 Noon to 8PM. Operation is on all bands...160 through 2 meters and all modes...CW/SSB/FM/Digital. The exchange is your RS(T) and county or RS(T) and state for non-Illinois stations. Best band will be 40M in the early to middle afternoon and 80M in the late afternoon to evening.

If you don't have HF gear, check out the activity on the FM simplex channels. FM contacts must be simplex and not through repeaters.

So...jump in and help out. You don't have to operate the entire contest. Just hop in anytime and make a few contacts. **Be sure to submit your log with "KANKAKEE AREA RADIO SOCIETY" for the club aggregate score!**
