

KARS Archives 1925



This QSL is a very important piece of KARS History

The QSL card shown below is that of Dr. J.R. Wilkinson, "9AZ" of Kankakee Illinois. The card was sent to "9APY" of Berwyn, IL in November 1925. The callsign 9AZ was changed to W9AZ in later years. The earliest record of W9AZ as a member of the Kankakee Amateur Radio Club; (a forerunner of the present club) is in early 1942. Dr. Wilkinson became a silent key in 1945. In 1962, research into the possibility of obtaining a two letter call for the Club Station was successful when it was learned that Dr Wilkinson had been a member in 1942. Application for a license was made with proper certificates submitted to the FCC and a license was issued in 1962. President of KARS in 1962 was Mervin Reed, K9CZA. The QSL was donated to KARS in 2001 by Paul Christensen W9AC, a very dear old friend of Clay N9IO.
