

The net meets every Monday at 2000 hours local time. All stations with or without traffic are invited to check in.



## **DX World DXpedition Calendar**




## AND THE DX JUST KEEPS ON A COMING!

As solar activity continues to build month after month, the DX opportunities and activity also soars.

Bands like 15, 12 & 10 Meters that for years seemed deader than the microwave bands are open to all parts of the world, often well after dark.

Are you getting in on your share of the DX action? Remember! The Solar activity cycle runs in 11 year cycles! The present cycle (#25) is predicted by NOAA to peak in 2024. The National Weather Service and the Royal Astronomical Society say the peak will be about the middle of 2025. Check out the NOAA Solar activity graph below.

Also, check out the DXpedition calendar above and see what you need towards your DXCC and other rewards. There a are lot of great DX operations who can't wait to QRV (get on the air) now that the Chinese Plague is finally over and everyone is free to travel again. Be sure to get your share!
